- Registration for the 2024-2025 school year is now underway, any day between 9:15-1:00 and 2:00-3:45 in our main office. If your child is currently enrolled in grades K-7, there is no action required—your spot is reserved. For incoming Kindergarten families, as well as any student new to the neighborhood or joining us through a GoCPS application, we will need you to come to the main office to register. - For all of our incoming Kindergarten students and families, we are hosting our annual Kindergarten Meet and Greet on Thursday, May 23, at 9:15am. Students will have a chance to be together in the Kindergarten classroom with Ms. McReynolds and Ms. Leiva, and parents will have the opportunity to learn more about the school and each other.
